DATE: OCTOBER 18, 2022 7:30 PM WORKSHOP

DISCUSSION ITEMS

- Drainage Plan Ordinance Discussion - Requested by Planning Board

- Mayor Higgins handed out a copy of Wall Township's grading plan and stated that the Planning Board held a discussion over the summer which has turned into an ongoing discussion for new building in town. Mayor Higgins stated that he is using this as an introduction to the Council to see if this is something that Lake Como would be interested in doing. If so, Mayor Higgins stated that he would invite the Planning Board Engineer and the Planning Board Chairperson to the next meeting. This proposed grading plan would put a lot of ownness on the builders to protect neighboring properties.
- Councilman Ventrice asked if this would be replacing an existing code to which mayor Higgins replied that there is not a current code in place which is why the Planning Board is making this recommendation. The Board has been seeing a lot of these questions coming up at meetings.
- Councilwoman Scull stated that this is a good start, but it would be great to hear from our engineer.
- Business Insurance Registry Discussion
 - Mayor Higgins stated that the State has passed a law requiring the town to host a directory of business owners, rental property homeowners and anyone owning a home with 4 or less units while living in that home to maintain a level of liability insurance on that property.
 - Borough attorney Peg Schaffer stated that a certificate of that insurance policy shall be filed with the Clerk of the town and the State allows the town to impose a reasonable cost associated with that.
 - Mayor Higgins stated that if the owners do not comply, they are liable for a fine between \$500.00 and \$5,000.00 and that is governed by our existing penalty ordinance. Mayor Higgins asked if the Council wants to impose a fee for this registration and asked

Ms. Schaffer to draft an ordinance for the next meeting. Ms. Schaffer stated she can check with other towns to see what they charge. Councilman D'Antuono asked if there was a compliance date that this needs to be in place. Mayor Higgins stated that the legislation went into effect in August and Ms. Schaffer stated that there are different timelines for different instances and she will have all of that at the next meeting.

Wall Twp Grading Code

For Discussion 1/18/22

A.140-116 Protection of natural features

Existing natural features such as streams, lakes, ponds and the natural configuration of the ground shall be retained where possible. If it can be demonstrated to the satisfaction of the Planning Board when reviewing applications for subdivisions, site plan or conditional uses, or to the satisfaction of the Board of Adjustment in all other cases, that such feature will substantially interfere with a permitted use of a property, such features may be altered only to the extent absolutely necessary to render premises suitable for such permitted use.

В.

Elevation alterations.

(1)

No alteration of any existing elevation of land or an approved grading plan shall be permitted without the written approval of the Township Engineer.

(2)

The existing elevation of any land in the Township shall not be altered more than two feet by means of soil removal, fill, or grading, except as part of an approved development application. Should the Township Engineer determine a proposed modification to an approved grading plan to be substantial, such approval shall be withheld and the applicant or developer shall be required to apply to the approving agency for approval or an amended grading plan.

Topsoil, sand and gravel.

No topsoil shall be removed from any premises in any zone. No subsoil, sand or gravel shall be removed from any premises in any zone except that:

Α.

The Land Use Officer may issue a permit for the removal of subsoil from excavations for building foundations or other structures, provided that the total amount to be removed from the lot does not exceed 500 cubic yards.

B.

The appropriate hearing agency for any development application may grant a temporary bulk variance for the removal of soil, sand or gravel other than as set forth in Subsection A above. Such removal shall also be regulated by Chapter 188, Soil Removal.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING MAYOR AND COUNCIL TO DECLARE HALLOWEEN CURFEW

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Lake Como that the Mayor and Council hereby declares a curfew on the use of streets and highways in all of the Borough of Lake Como, between the hours of 8 o'clock in the evening prevailing time and 6 o'clock in the morning prevailing time each day, beginning at 8 p.m. on October 29, 2022 and ending at 6 a.m. on November 1, 2022. During such hours, no person under the age of 18 shall remain in or upon any public street, highway or place except those accompanied by a parent or guardian and except those who are going directly between their home and place of work or school.
