

# ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF LAKE COMO AMENDING SECTION 17-9.1(e)1 OF THE BOROUGH CODE

WHEREAS, the Planning Board of the Borough of Lake Como has advised the Borough Council that clarification of the Borough Code's Lot Coverage Ordinance is necessary; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council of the Borough of Lake Como believes it to be in the public interest to amend the relevant code section;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Lake Como that § 17-9.1(e)1 of the Borough Code of the Borough of Lake Como be amended to read:

# 17-9.1(e)1 Maximum Lot Coverage.

Building area coverage shall be limited to a maximum of 40% of the total lot area for buildings, including the principal building, accessory buildings and decks. Building area coverage shall be 35% on undersized lots or 40% with a garage.

# ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF LAKE COMO AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS KNOWN AS LOT 24, BLOCK 31 FROM GREGORY AND DEBORAH RODRIGUEZ

WHEREAS, the Borough of Lake Como (the "Borough) is interested in purchasing property adjacent to the former South Belmar First Aid Squad property, which was acquired by the Borough of Lake Como last year; and

WHEREAS, Gregory and Deborah Rodriguez (the "Rodriguezes") are the owners of certain property located at 705 Eighteenth Avenue in the Borough of Lake Como and designated as Lot 24 in Block 31on the Tax Map of the Borough of Lake Como (the "Property"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough and the Rodriguezes have entered into a Contract of Sale for the Property as of July 12, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Lake Como believe it to be in the best interest of the citizens of Lake Como to acquire the Property; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by Mayor and Council of the Borough of Lake Como, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor, Borough Clerk and Borough Attorney are hereby authorized and directed to execute any and all documents as are reasonably necessary to acquire fee simple title to the portion of the Property currently owned by the Rodriguezes, including all improvements erected on, over and beneath aforesaid lands to be acquired; and all easements, rights-of-way or uses, privileges, licenses, hereditaments, appurtenances, interests and other rights belonging to or inuring to the benefit of the lands to be acquired and all right, title and interest of the owners in and to any land lying in the bed of any highway, street, road or avenue, opened or proposed, in front or abutting or adjoining aforesaid lands to be acquired.

- <u>Section 2.</u> The purchase price for the Property to be acquired shall be Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00).
- <u>Section 3.</u> The Mayor and Borough Clerk are hereby authorized to accept the Deed transferring the Property to the Borough, provided the Deed is in a form satisfactory to the Borough Attorney.

**Section 4.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

<u>Section 5.</u> If any section, subdivision, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication as provided by law.
