PUBLIC COMMENTS

Councilman Witte made a motion to open the meeting to the public, seconded by Councilman D'Antuono, all are in favor.

- Warren Kehrwieder of Main Street came before the Council to ask about cars being parked on the street for weeks at a time, causing the sweeper to not be able to sweep the street. Chief Huisman asked Mr. Kehrwieder to call him in the morning and they will discuss this and Mayor Higgins asked Borough Attorney Peg Schaffer to look into the state rules and the Borough Ordinances.
- Lillian Bertoldo of 17th Avenue came before the Council to express her concerns with the water that pools at 17th Avenue and floods he driveway. Mayor Higgins stated that the Ordinance adopted tonight for the NJDOT grant will improve 17th Avenue but in the meantime, Brendan from DPW will come out and look at the sump that may be causing the flooding.
- Polly Dell'Omo of 17th Avenue came before the Council to second what Ms. Bertoldo stated about the water at 17th Avenue. She stated that the only storm drain for 2 blocks is by her house and the water freezes in the winter and is dangerous. Mayor Higgins stated that he will ask the engineer to look for a temporary solution.
- Barbara Frank of 22nd Avenue came before the Council and asked if senior citizens could be exempt from school tax, Mayor Higgins responded that it is a state law and that everyone has to pay the school tax. Mrs. Frank also asked about the candle light vigil that was held at the lake. Councilwoman Scull responded that she organized it as a concerned citizen and if there was a cause she felt strongly about, she could organize a vigil.
- Michael Ryan of E Street came before the Council and thanked the Mayor, Council and the office for putting together a memorial service for former Councilman Basil Wolfe. Mayor Ryan is also asking the Council to volunteer to help at the water stop for the NJFMBA Fallen Heroes Run. Mayor Ryan stated that as the Democratic Municipal Chairman, he will also be interviewing for Councilman Carvelli's replacement.
