#### **ORDINANCE NO. 2018-935**

# ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF LAKE COMO AMENDING CHAPTER 14-2 "REGULATIONS GOVERNING CONNECTIONS TO SEWER SYSTEM" OF THE BOROUGH CODE

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Lake Como ("Borough") believes it to be in the public interest to make certain changes to the regulations governing connections to the Borough's sanitary sewer system;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Lake Como, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey that § 14-2.2 of the Code of the Borough of Lake Como be and is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 1: § 14-2.2 (b) shall be repealed and replaced with the following: All connections, directly or indirectly, to the sanitary sewer system for sump pumps, roof leaders, areaway drains, swimming pools, ornamental ponds, water-cooled refrigeration, air-conditioning units, fire sprinkler systems and any other similar connections are hereby prohibited.

SECTION 2: § 14-2.2(c) shall be added as follows: <u>Violations and penalties</u>. Any person who is found to be in violation of the provisions of this section shall be subject to a fine in accordance with the General Penalty, Section 1-5 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Lake Como.

**SECTION 3.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**SECTION 4.** If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision so adjudged, and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

**SECTION 5.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication as provided by law.

SO ORDAINED as aforesaid.
