Please be advised that on or about Wednesday, May 9, 2018, weather permitting, a temporary water main shutdown is scheduled to be performed for the water system improvements along Woodland Place as part of the above referenced project. The temporary shutdown will begin at 9:00am and services should be restored by 1:00pm.

Our office will have a representative on-site during construction to monitor the work of the contractor, DewCon, Inc. (908-832-5710). We will attempt to coordinate any work to be done in your area in order to minimize possible inconveniences.

At certain times the road may have to be closed to traffic except to those residents who live within the project limits. During this period, detours will be posted. It is expected that no work will be done on weekends or major holidays unless absolutely necessary.
