Hello Renter,

Welcome to beautiful Lake Como. This year, more than ever, I am happy to have you as our guest this summer season. However, this year more than ever, I ask that you treat our town as if it were your own. With the global pandemic still among us, I ask that you follow social distancing guidelines when out and about in our community. Please wear a mask when entering any business and try your best to keep a six foot distance from others when in public.

As seasonal renters you are considered residents of Lake Como, therefore you must follow the same guidelines and restrictions placed on all residents during this state of emergency.

- **Lake Como has instituted a parking permit system for the duration of Governor Murphy's State of Emergency. Only cars with the Green LC sticker will be permitted to park on the street during this time.** The property owner should have supplied you with stickers based upon the home's certificate of occupancy. Cars without the LC sticker will be ticketed and possibly towed. Makeshift signs placed within the car window will not be allowed as a substitute for a sticker.
- **Executive Order 107** declares a stay at home order by the governor of New Jersey. While the state of emergency is in effect all residents must abide by this rule. If you must leave your home for essential business, please wear personal protective equipment including a face covering, and gloves when needed. Keep a social distance of at least six (6) feet at all times.
- **No gatherings of more than Ten (10) people.** Unless the certificate of occupancy allows for more than Ten (10) people to occupy the house, at no time should there be a gathering of more than Ten (10) people. No resident of Lake Como should be having large gatherings of any kind during this time of emergency.

Violation of any of these orders, including Lake Como's "Animal House" Ordinances, may result in a summons and/or eviction. It is my hope that everyone can enjoy a safe and healthy summer. I ask you, and all the residents of Lake Como to enjoy the borough and the Summer responsibly.
