WHEREAS, certain federal funds are potentially available to Monmouth County through the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development has allocated funding to the County of Monmouth for Fiscal Year 2023; and

WHEREAS, the County is making some of these funds available to certain participating municipalities and non-profit agencies; and

WHEREAS, it is required that the **Borough of Lake Como** execute a Project Agreement with Monmouth County to undertake a project known as Improvements to Behrman Park and WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development is requiring that the Mayor of the **Borough of Lake Como** sign additional certifications in order to receive these funds; and

WHEREAS, the **Borough of Lake Como** has adopted a policy prohibiting the use of excessive force by its law enforcement agency (police force) within its jurisdiction against any individuals engaged in non-violent civil rights demonstrations; and

WHEREAS, a copy of that policy is attached to and made part of this resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the **Borough of Lake Como** has met the conditions of receiving a Fiscal Year 2023 allocation by adopting a policy prohibiting the use of excessive force and by not using federal funds for lobbying or by disclosing that funds have been used for lobbying.

FOR: Borough of Lake Como

In accordance with section 519 of Public Law 101-140, the 1990 HUD Appropriations Act, the Borough of Lake Como certifies that it has adopted and is enforcing a policy prohibiting the use of excessive force by law enforcement agencies within its jurisdiction against any individuals engaged in nonviolent civil rights demonstrations.

The Borough of Lake Como also certifies that it is enforcing applicable State and local laws against physically barring entrance to or exit from a facility or location which is the subject of nonviolent civil rights demonstrations within its jurisdiction.
