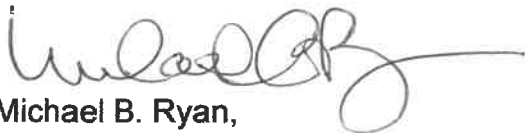

Response: The separate accounts are accounted for with their own account numbers, however, new account assignments that correlate directly to the respective accounts so it doesn't appear that they are part of the current account and become trust accounts.

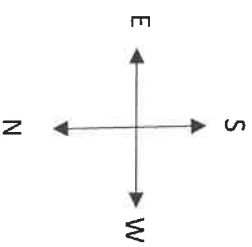
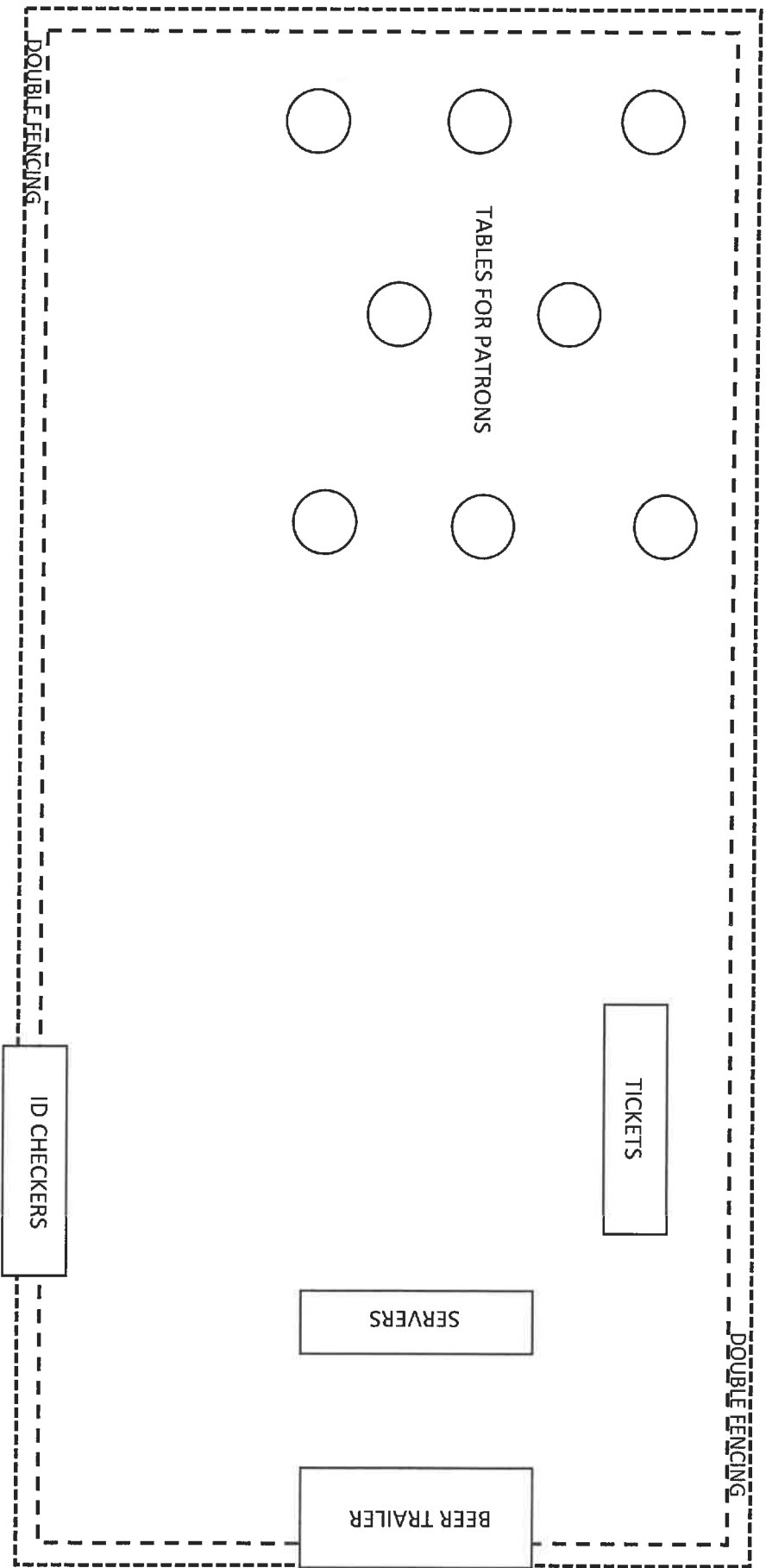
